The Audi Prize always guarantees top-level sport in the Brabanthallen with a strong international field of competitors at the start. Last year, it was Rolex Testimonee Daniel Deusser who claimed victory with Otello de Guldenboom after a spectacular jump-off. This year too, he is aiming for the win. "We always enjoy coming to The Dutch Masters and have achieved many good results here. I'll try to defend my title, but everything has to click and you also need a bit of luck," says Deusser. For Kim Emmen, who is supported by Van Mossel Group, the class is primarily about development. The Dutch rider uses the competition to give her younger horses experience at the highest level. "This weekend, our emerging talents are in the spotlight," explains Emmen. "We're seeing how they feel and how quickly they develop. If they're really in the flow, that's already very nice—it's a perfect lead-up to the future."



Tonight marks the spectacular Van Schijndel Bouwgroep Indoor Derby. This derby is a traditional part evening program each year, where riders compete against each other in a long and impressive course. Piet Raijmakers Jr. is there every single time: "Those who participate in a derby do it truly for the spectacle—they really go for it. For the audience, this is also a massive class to watch, which you can see from the turnout and the enthusiasm of the crowd. The thing is, this derby isn't necessarily technically difficult to ride, but rather long. Much longer than a normal course. So you really need to know how to pace yourself and not burn all your energy in the first part of your course. Stay concentrated all the way to the end, so you don't lose it just before the finish line. That's what I personally find the most difficult, and it's also the trick to riding a good derby."




